Update on my Autogyro Build By Paul Csornok

Well, many of you have been keeping up with my progress on my Gyrobee Autogyro, which has not been moving as quickly as I would have liked, but is making progress.

Over the winter, I purchased a use 503 53hp Rotax, a rebuilt "B" gearbox. It took me till just about a month ago to find the time to get everything done and installed. This required fabricating the engine mounts for it.

My propeller was received from GSC a couple of weeks ago and is now mounted on the machine. A beautiful 3 blade Maple prop with polished aluminum hub.

My gages have been received (MGL Flight-2 and E-1 engine monitor), throttle, cables, sensors, and a bunch of hardware for the fiberglass tail I am in the process of building have also been in my possession, just looking for the time to put it all together.

Once my gas tank arrives, I am going to plumb everything and do my break-in of the rebuilt engine.

With July here already, the summer is moving fast. I was hoping to have everything done and start my flight training, but that may not happen this summer. Only time will tell.
