Taxing went great and I was starting to get the gyro light on it's wheels, and having a blast doing it. I was heading back down to the end of the runway for what was going to be my last run. I should have quit earlier. As I was approaching the end to turn around, I was closer to the edge than I had been before. Something told me to stop and move the gyro by hand. I didn't. I was starting to make my turn when the left wheel went off of the runway onto the Freshly Plowed field and the wheel got caught. With my taking speed, plus the power setting to make my turn and the nose wheel turned, the gyro tipped over and trashed the rotor blades. My propeller also broke, but didn't cause the engine to shut down, and my E-1 Engine Monitor gauge ended up getting cracked.

If I had just listened to that inner voice, I would probably be doing some ground hopping and have more money in my pocket. LISTEN TO THAT INNER VOICE!!!
